Grade "A" Paper

Light colored paper & folders (no astrobrights/fluorescents). Copy paper, manila file folders, printer paper, white paper.

Grade "B" Paper

Brochures, catalogs, magazines, junk mail, paperpack books, phone books (call about hardback books).

Prices subject to change. ALL paper must be flattened, and some separated.**

PLEASE ASK FOR DETAILS

For all non-ferrous metal transactions (except aluminum cans), you must bring a current and valid government-issued photo ID, and provide a current street address & phone number. We pay the first \$30 in cash. Any remaining balance is paid by with a non-transferrable check which is issued at the time of the transaction.

No Punched ID!

No Prison ID!

*All items subject to physical inspection.

We Charge to Recycle These Items:

Appliances

Refrigerated appliances are a charge of 10 cents per pound with a \$20 minimum per unit A/C and dorm fridges are \$12.50 minimum per unit

Glass Bottles & Jars

Clean, rinsed, and unbroken 15 cents per pound, \$1 minimum. Keep glass & tin separate.

Plastic Bottles

We accept rinsed CODE 1 PETE and most CODE 2 HDPE plastic bottles. No tubs or yogurt containers. Call for current charges.

Wood Waste

Junk pallets, branches, etc. Call for details.

Electronic Waste

Some electronics have a charge of 30 cents a pound to recycle. Includes mice, keyboards, printers, stereos, VCRs, DVD players & more!

Fluorescent Lights

No broken bulbs. Call for Prices.

Secure Document Destruction

Recycle sensitive documents! They're kept secure and recycled into building materials. The charge is 15 cents per pound; \$10 minimum. Call for details.
